April 30 is International Jazz Day and it's being recognized in Peterborough with a city proclamation of April 30 as Jazz Day and a series of shows on April 29 and 30.

On April 29 from 6 to 8 p.m., there will be several restaurant performances:

- Amandala's (375 Water St.), jazz guitarist Mike Graham will perform with jazz violinist Victoria Yeh.
- La Hacienda (190 Hunter St. W.), jazz from pianist Pete Woolidge and guitarist Michael Monis.
- Curry Village (306 George St. N.), jazz from bassist Chris Parnis and guitarist Miles Cakebread-Kraus.
- Nateure's Plate (182 Charlotte St.), jazz from the Rob Philips Trio, with Dennis Pendrith on bass and Curtis Cronkwright on drums.

There's also a pub performance on April 29 from 9 to 11 p.m. (with no cover charge) at the Black Horse Pub (452 George St. N.) jazz singer Denielle Bassels.

The feature concert is on April 30 from 2 to 4 p.m. with jazz ensemble Time Warp at Market Hall Performance Centre.
